New Haven Farm Home seeks to provide a service for clients that incorporates a planned approach in providing support to the individual which will in meeting his or her personal needs by providing assistance; developing relevant skills; and providing opportunities at home and in their local communities.

New Haven Farm Home is committed to provide each client with a person-centred plan, which is regularly reviewed and adjusted based on individual preferences and support requirements. A Person-Centred Plan is an individualised approach for the person with a disability to discover what he or she really wants out of life. A Person-Centred Plan is transformational, moving from an approach geared towards fixing or solving problems, to one focused on providing opportunities, avenues for self-actualisation, personal freedom, meaningful interdependence, and community involvement.

Consequently, during this process, it is likely that the client will ask for things that challenge the family and the service provider in unexpected ways. This is a positive and necessary part of Person-Centred Planning. And, with the proper support from family and New Haven Farm Home it can open up new possibilities for everyone involved.

Clients, their families, friends and advocates are to be incorporated in the opportunities to foster empowerment & individual choice by enabling greater input into decisions on their priority of needs and personal goals within the scope of the service to be provided.
