



NEW HAVEN FARM HOME SERVICE ENTRY POLICY STATEMENT

New Haven Farm Home ensures that all people who are applying to enter the service receive equitable and non-discriminatory assessment measured against objective criteria. The application process is fair, equitable and non-discriminatory; consideration is given to all persons seeking service entry. Persons of CALD & Aboriginal heritage are actively encouraged to apply to enter the service.

New Haven Farm Home aims to make the process of coming into our Service as uncomplicated and fair as possible. We accept requests for support from all sources, including people with an intellectual disability themselves. An open referral system is in place, which is managed by the DADHC Regional Accommodation Placement Committee, and clearly shows people who can apply for support services, how they can apply, and how decisions about applications are made. Each applicant will be assessed on an individual needs basis in a fair and equitable manner and with full application of the prescribed criteria.

However, New Haven Farm Home, through its Board, always retains the right to final decision making as to the suitability or otherwise of individuals seeking service entry and as to whether New Haven Farm Home is able to meet individual needs of any potential client who's placement has been proposed by the Placement Committee.
