New Haven Farm Home recognises that people may move on from our Service for a range of different reasons, and that we may, at times, need to ask people to leave the service.

New Haven Farm Home will assist clients who are leaving the Service in a way that respects their decisions, and we will actively support them to access other Services that will meet their needs. When we need to ask a person to leave the service, we will follow a clear and fair process, which gives people the reasons for such a decision and supports them to find alternative support arrangements.

New Haven Farm Home ensures that fair, equitable and non-discriminatory consideration is given to all persons seeking to exit the service or who are required to leave New Haven Farm Home. Decisions in relation to the circumstance that may require a client to leave New Haven Farm Home are made in a fair and equitable manner and with full application of the identified procedures.

New Haven Farm Home, through its Board, always retains the right to final decision making as to whether New Haven Farm Home is able to meet individual needs of any client who has been accepted for placement.

New Haven Farm will assist clients, families and advocates in understanding the process for leaving our Service.
